**Competition system:** The Competition is judged on accuracy in hitting the target. .

- 1) Team Competition: Team of 3 archers of each country in sitting position (zasha)
  - (1) Preliminary: 12 arrows/each team ( 4 arrows x 3 archers)  
First 8 Teams go to Final
  - (2) Final: 12 arrows ( 4 arrows X 3 archers)
  - (3) Kyosya: 1 arrow X 3 archers in case of same points
  
- 2) Individual Competition: 5 archers in sitting position (zasha)
  - (1) Preliminary: 2 arrows each archer  
KAICHU-SHA (the archers scoring 2 hits) go to Final
  - (2) Hoshi-Mato (white target with black center) of 24cm is used for Final  
IZUME- Kyosha (shooting until missing the target) is used to decide the Champion.
  - (3) Apart from the champion, ENKIN-Kyosha (distance from the center of the target) is used

**Dress Code** White Kyudogi, white TABI, black HAKAMA  
A name tag is given at the reception.

**Qualification** (1) Membership of an affiliated organization of the International Kyudo Federation  
(2) Participation of non affiliated organization is admitted.

**Recognition** The first three are recognized in Team Competition  
The first five are recognized in Individual Competition
