Qualification: The second International seminar participants who meet the following requirements

Category	Qualification
Mushitei	No Requirements
2 nd dan ~ 4 th dan	1 st dan ~ 3 rd dan should be certified from the Federation by 23, November 2009
5 th dan	4 th dan should be certified from the Federation by 29, November 2009
6 th dan & Renshi	5 th dan should be certified from the Federation by 29, April 2009

Guidelines for Examination

- Mushitei to 6th dan: Grade and titled ranks are awarded according to the overall points scored in Gyosha test and by a written test.

- (1) Gyosha: Conducted in Test Timing.
- (2) Written test: A written test will be holding subjects relating to Kyudo

- Renshi: The title is awarded according to the overall points scored in Gyosha, test, assessment of candidate's leadership qualities and by a written test.

- (1) Gyosha: The second round examination will be conducted for those that qualify from the initial examination.
- (2) Interview: The character, insight, and leadership of the qualifiers will be examined.
- (3) Written test: A written test will be conducted in subjects relating to Kyudo.

□5th dan ~ 6th dan, and Renshi: 「Tasuki Sabaki」 will be examined.

Application

- (1) Through the German Federation DKyuB
- (2) Deadline 11th of January 2010

Matters that require attention

- (1) Pay adequate attention to the deadline provided by the Federation you belong to when you apply.
- (2) In case the application contains false information, the result of the examination may become invalid.
- (3) Examinees should be in the venue by the starting time.
- (4) Examinees for 4th dan to 6th dan, and Renshi must wear Wafuku (Kimono).
- (5) Examinees will be considered withdrawn when they are late for the examination or fail to answer their name when called.
- (6) If taking the examination in the form of Rissha, (standing position) inform us by writing that in red in the application form (under the point; Kyudo Career), attach a copy of the physical disability certificate or a certificate issued by a medical institution (effective for one year from the effective date, copy acceptable) to prove the cause, and apply after receiving an attestation from the local federation president.

Regarding The use of the personal information given in the application:

By submitting the application form, prior consent will be deemed to have been obtained from examinees concerning handling of the related materials as follows;

- (1) Registration list and related materials (including lists of examinees : Name, Membership of local federation, Age, Shogo title already acquired and date awarded, Rank already acquired and date approved, Any special instructions)
- (2) Shooting-order list (Name, Membership of local federation)
- (3) Examination results lists and reports for the Federation publication (in-house journals and others) (Name, Membership of local federation, Shogo or Dan)
