Dear National Representatives! Now all forms for the IKYF events in Paris this summer have arrived. Attached you will find all the necessary information.

Deadline for your applications reaching the office of the German Federation is the 26th of April, so that we have enough time to check the applications and sign them, before posting them to Japan. Please take care to use the given alternative adress for the applications!

Please note the following points:

- Examination is only possible for seminar participants.
- Application only for the Taikai is possible. One team per country, Individuals: open numbers.
- Students up to 25 years of age only pay half the registration fee for the Taikai.
 (25 instead of 50 Euros). Procedure of competition see on the Taikai Information sheet of the IKYF.
- The seminars will take place on the following dates:

B1 und C1: 10. July until 12 July, Examination 13. July, english speakers.

B2 und C2: 21 July until 23 July, Examination 24. July, french speakers.

B3 und C3: 25. July until 27 July, Examination 28. July, german speakers.

A: 15. July until17 July, Examination 18. July, international.

Application to all seminars is possible as long as people are able to follow the seminar language. The written test should also be so far as possible in the seminar language.
