Dear Kyudo friends,

I hope that this message finds you well and in good health.

Similar to the pandemic situation year ago the Finnish Kyudo Federation has cancelled our traditional Heki Summer Seminar in Pajulahti and has scheduled a four day Seminar be held on 12.-15.8 at the training facilities used by the Helsinki Kyudo club (Tuulimäki sports hall, Itätuulentie 9, 02100 Espoo; Metro station Tapiola). The scheduled start of the Seminar is on 12.8 at 12:00 and end on 15.8 at 17:00 with possibility for free training during the Thursday, Friday and Saturday evenings. The tentative participation fee is 120€ for the full Seminar (includes coffee/tea and sandwich lunches).

Feliks Hoff Sensei and Cornelia Brandl-Hoff Sensei have offered to lead the Seminar and due to the fact that (at least here in Finland) we have had a long break in Kyudo training caused by the pandemic regulations the Senseis have suggested that the Seminar will focus on brushing-up the Kyudo basics.
