APPLICATION METHOD

Individual Taikai: The members of each country register with their national kyudo federation which assembles all the information in the EXCEL file (attached)

Team Taikai: The national federation designate members of team including reserves and register them in the EXCEL file.

REQUIREMENTS

1 team of 3 archers per country (a reserve per team optional)

Double entry (for team and individual) is possible.

The minimum age is 16 years old with no upper age limit.

The event is open to both men and women.

The minimum grade for participants is shodan.

The competitions will be held in kneeling form zasha if time allows. Otherwise, standing form rissha will be used.

SCORING

The EKF taikai will start with the pre-rounds / i. e. rounds before the final rounds / based on the principle of saiten-seido: awarding points for the overall performance: Taihai, Hassetsu, Tekichu. The 30% best ones of these pre-rounds will enter the final rounds based on tekichuseido, i. e. awarding points for the number of hits.

For the individual competition: saiten seido will be used in the pre-rounds (2 rounds) with two arrows (hitote) and shinsa no maai. In addition, a minimum of 2 hits (out of 4) will be needed for the finals. The top 30% will qualify for the finals.

The finals will use kyogi no maai with the (tekichu and) izume system with one arrow to award the first place. Second and third place will use enkin system if required.

For the team competition: saiten seido will be used in the pre-rounds (2 rounds) with four arrows (futate) and kyogi no maai. In addition, a minimum of 9 hits (out of 24) will be required to qualify for the finals.

The finals will use kyogi no maai with 1-2 rounds with four arrows (futate). The team competition will follow the tournament method based on the number of hits with tie breaks following the izume method for 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} place.

AWARDS

Both team and individual competitions will have 1st, 2nd and 3rd places awarded. 1st, 2nd and 3rd places will receive an award certificate, and the 1st place holders will hold the team and individual trophy until the next EKF Taikai. Their achievement will be recorded on a ribbon to be attached to the trophy.

EQUIPMENT and **CLOTHING**

Equipment and clothing must follow the accepted requirement: standard yumi, ya and feathers and yugake (no marks on equipment), white kyudogi and tabi, black hakama.
