Dear National Representatives!

Today we received the forms for the ANKF/IKYF events in Paris this summer.  
Attached you will find all the necessary information.

Deadline for your applications reaching the office of the German Federation is the 12<sup>th</sup> of May, so that we have enough time to check the applications and sign them, before posting them to Japan. Please take care to use the given alternative address for the applications!

Please note the following points:

1. Examination is only possible for seminar participants.
2. Taikai /Enbukai participants also have to take part in the seminars. One team per country, Individuals: open numbers.
3. Students up to 25 years of age only pay half the registration fee for the Taikai. (25 instead of 50 Euros). Team Competition: 3 Persons, each will shoot 4 arrows. 3 Person tachi. Individuals: 4 arrows each, also in 3 Person tachi.
4. The seminars will take place on the following dates:  
C: 16th. and 17th. July 2012, only 2 days, examination 18th. July.  
B: 19th, 20th and 21st. July, examination 22<sup>nd</sup> of July.  
A: 24th., 25th. and 26th. July, examination 27th July.

39 avenue Bernanos 75005, Paris, France  
Examination candidates for 5., 6. Dan and Renshi need a kimono.  
Questions for the written examination will be sent beforehand, the answers have to be handed in by registration in Paris.  
Costs will be added up from seminar fee, examination fee, taikai/enbukai participation fee. The fees you will find on the information sheets.  
Accommodation and travel are to be booked individually, as well as breakfast

and dinner. The organizers provide a list with youth hostels and budget hotels.  
4-bed rooms from 18 Euro per person.

5. Lunch on examination day is not included.
6. The information sheets are in english and japanese.
7. On the evening of the Taikai will be a party for A-Seminar participants and Federation officials. The fee will be 40 Euro. There are no application forms, maybe the registration is made on the spot
8. IKYF General meeting will take place on July the 24<sup>th</sup>.
9. Please note the statement on data security related to the use of personal data in the ANKF magazine and on the relevant homepages on the information sheet of the Taikai/Enbukai.



Dear National Representatives!

Now we have received the final application information.

For the application via the German Kyudo Federation you will need:

- The examination application form (with the right examination date, see below).  
(If you don't trust postal services to be in time, you can send copies of the form per pdf, as backup)
- The application form of the German Kyudo Federation
- Copy of money transfer to our banking account (application and handling fees, see application form for the German Kyudo Federation)
- Medical certificate, not older than 6 months at the date of the examination, if you are going to shoot in standing form.
- The filled out application excel form (only this form should be send back by email)

All this forms should arrive at the Federations office before Mai the 12<sup>th</sup> 2012. (in the offices letterbox!)

If you have passed the examination successfully you will have to pay a diploma fee.
