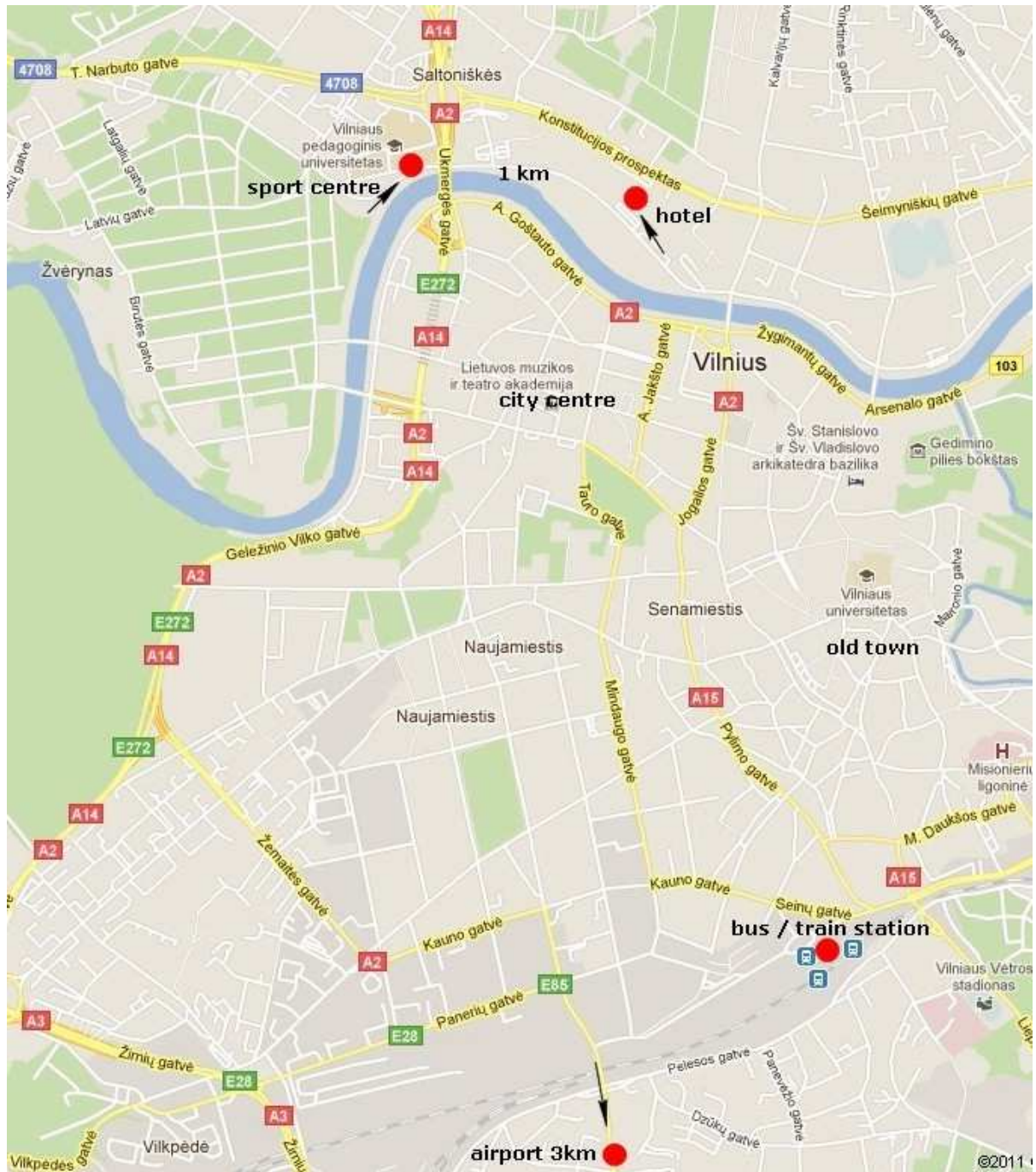

Religion: Roman Catholic ~80 % (Lithuania was the last pagan country in Europe to become Christian in 1387).
