Delay of the payments by the due date (February 1<sup>st</sup> 2013) will bring the organization of this Taikai in danger.

## Application procedure

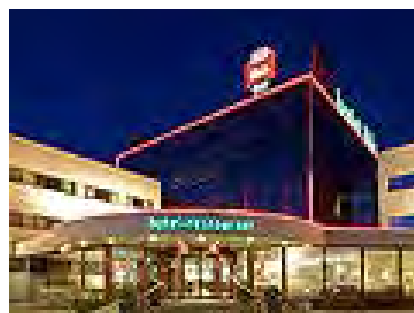

If a country cannot send a minimum team of 3 persons they are allowed to send a maximum of 2 archers to join with other nominal team members to meet the qualification for the individuals. Please name such archers as participant for the "individual taikai only". Names of the participants and companions must be submitted no later than **April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2013**.
