Dear Kyudoka,

I am pleased to inform you that in 2018 Kyudo Club "Tametomo" from Lesznowola under patronage of Polish Kyudo Association and with your help will hold the 100 arrows taikai. There will be a 4th edition of the tournament.

We have chosen the following term – 12 May 2018. The competition will be held in the Center for Education and Sports, Mysiadło, ul. Kwiatowa, Poland (almost Warsaw).

The duration of the competition will be one day.

We start at 8:00 and end when the last kyudoka shoots her/his last hundredth arrow.

Due to the size of the tournament's venue, the maximum number of attending shooters will be 36.

We will use the chronologic order of the pre-registrations as a selection method. The closing date for applications will be 30 March 2018. The deadline for the definite confirmation of your participation and fee payment will be 14 April 2018.

There will be a "waiting-list" in which following applicants will be added after the attendance limit is reached, so they will have the opportunity to attend the competition if one or more pre-registered participants would turn down.

The participation fee will be 25.00 €.

After the pre-registration you will be sent a detailed program, which won't be much different from:

- Saturday, 12 May:
 - 8:00 Rei
 - 8:10 draw of the starting numbers
 - 8:35 individual competition 100 arrows per Kyudoka
 - Around 18:00 - closing of the competition, results

I hope you will welcome this initiative as a possibility to meet and to compete with friends.
